



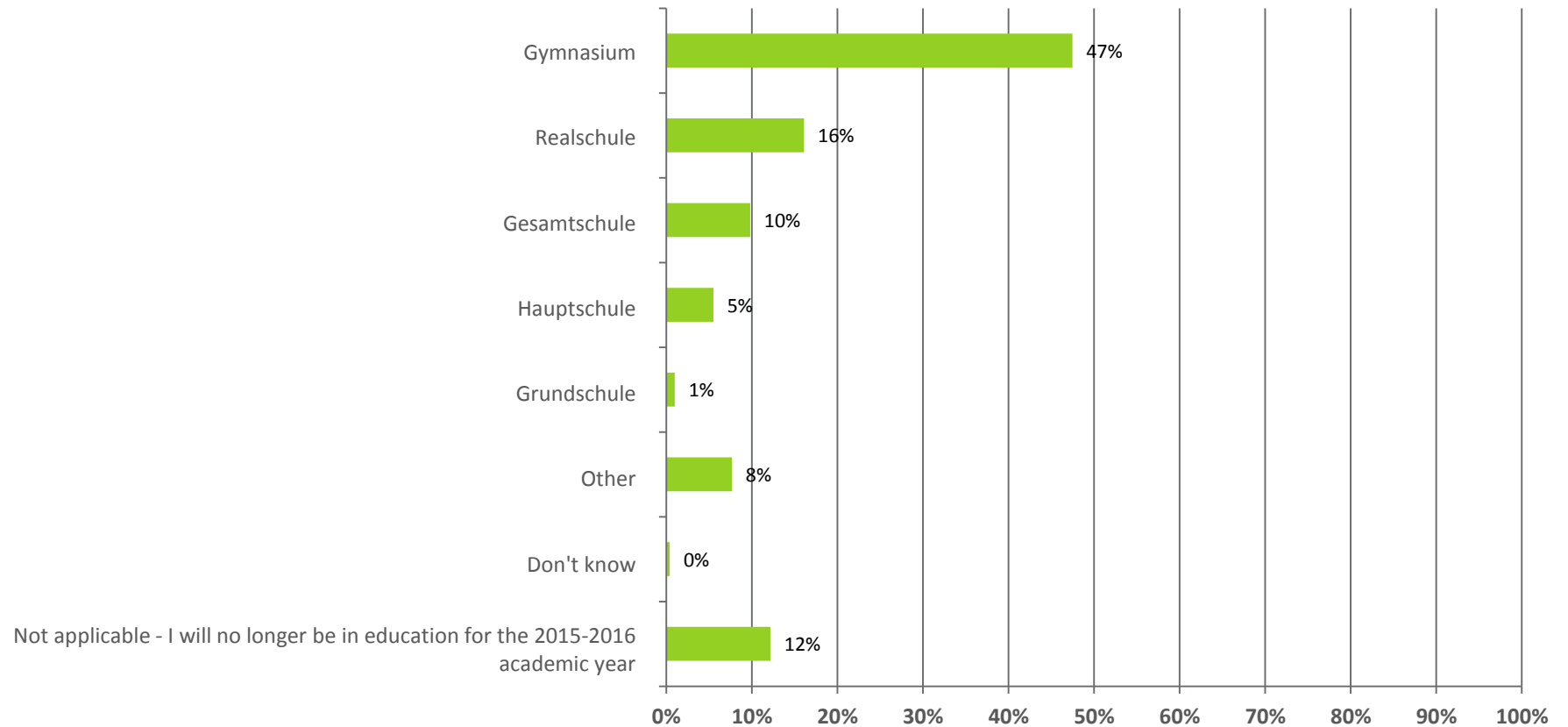
Cyberbullying – Merged Unweighted

Total sample size was 4,720 13-18 year olds in the UK, Germany, Italy, Spain, Netherlands, New Zealand, Greece, South Africa, USA, Ireland & Czech Republic. Fieldwork was undertaken between 1st - 14th September 2015. The survey was carried out online. The figures have been given an even weighting for each country to produce an 'average' value.



School Type

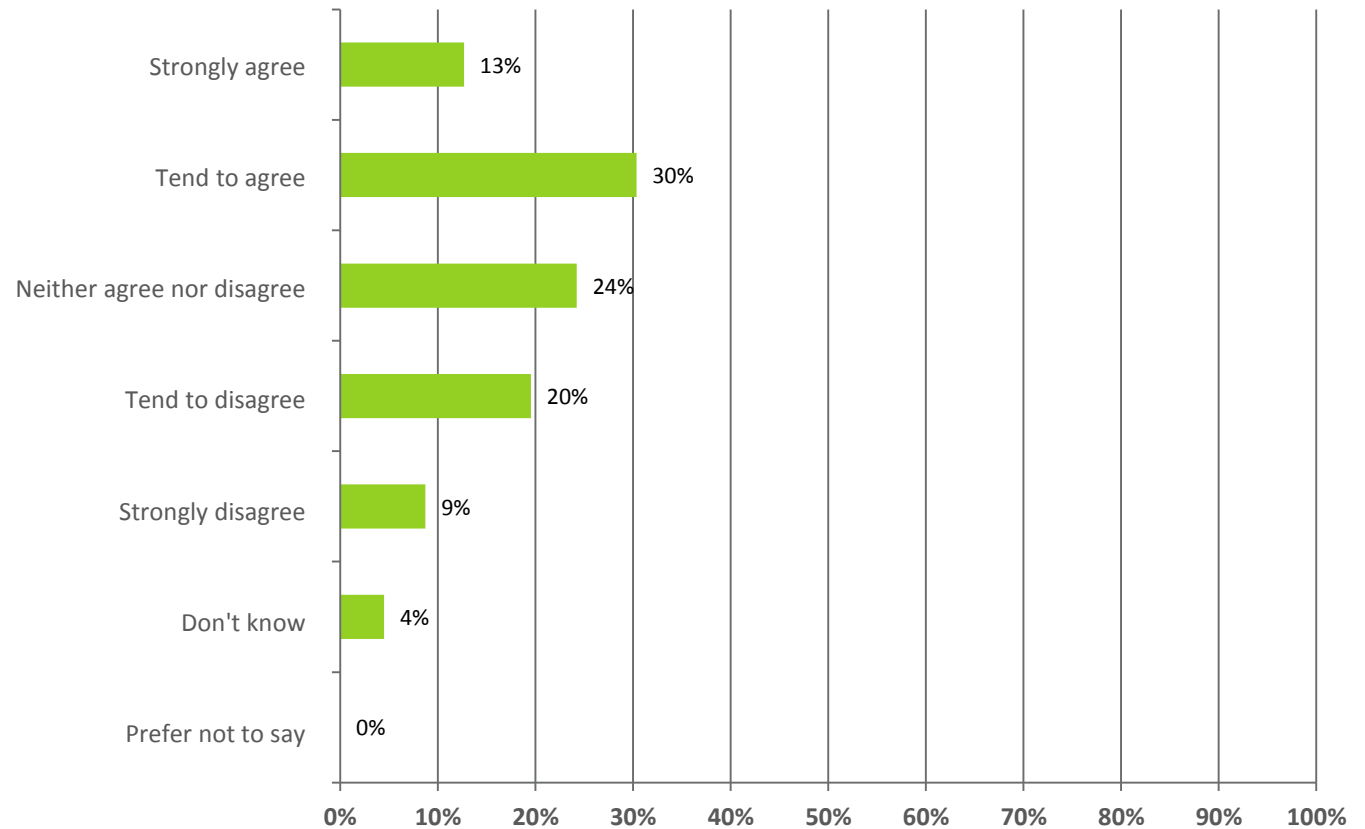

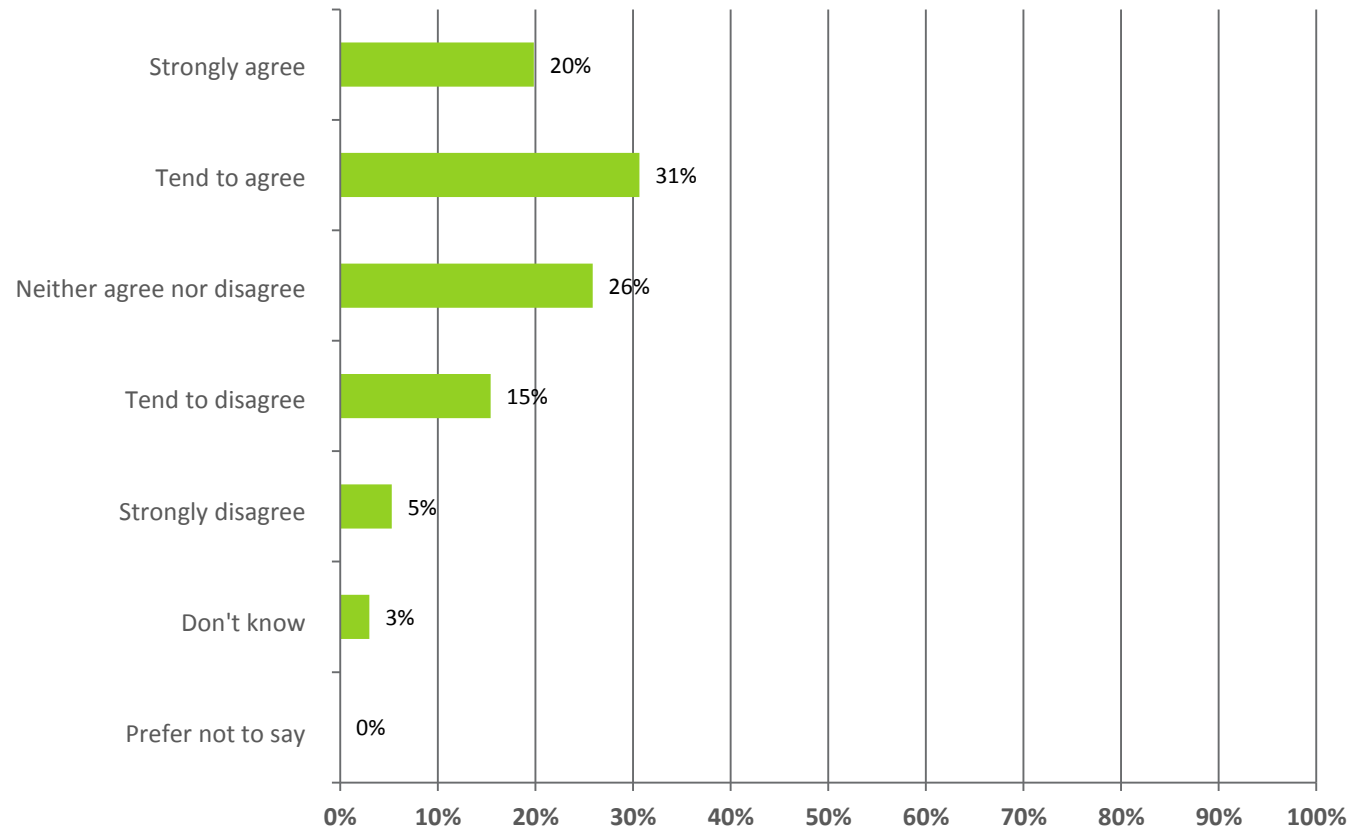
EVC_Q10_1. Cyberbullying is a bigger problem for young people than drug abuse (i.e. regularly taking illegal drugs)

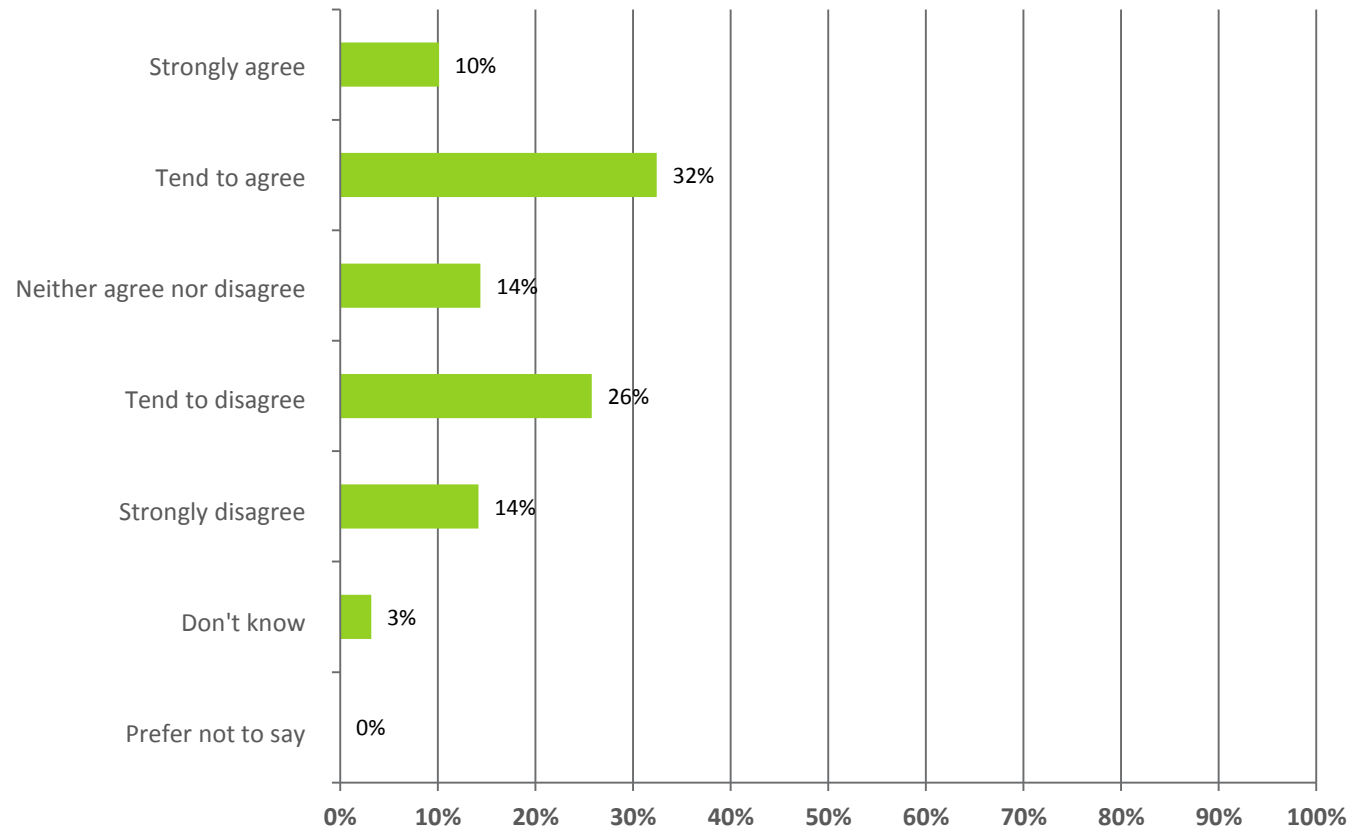

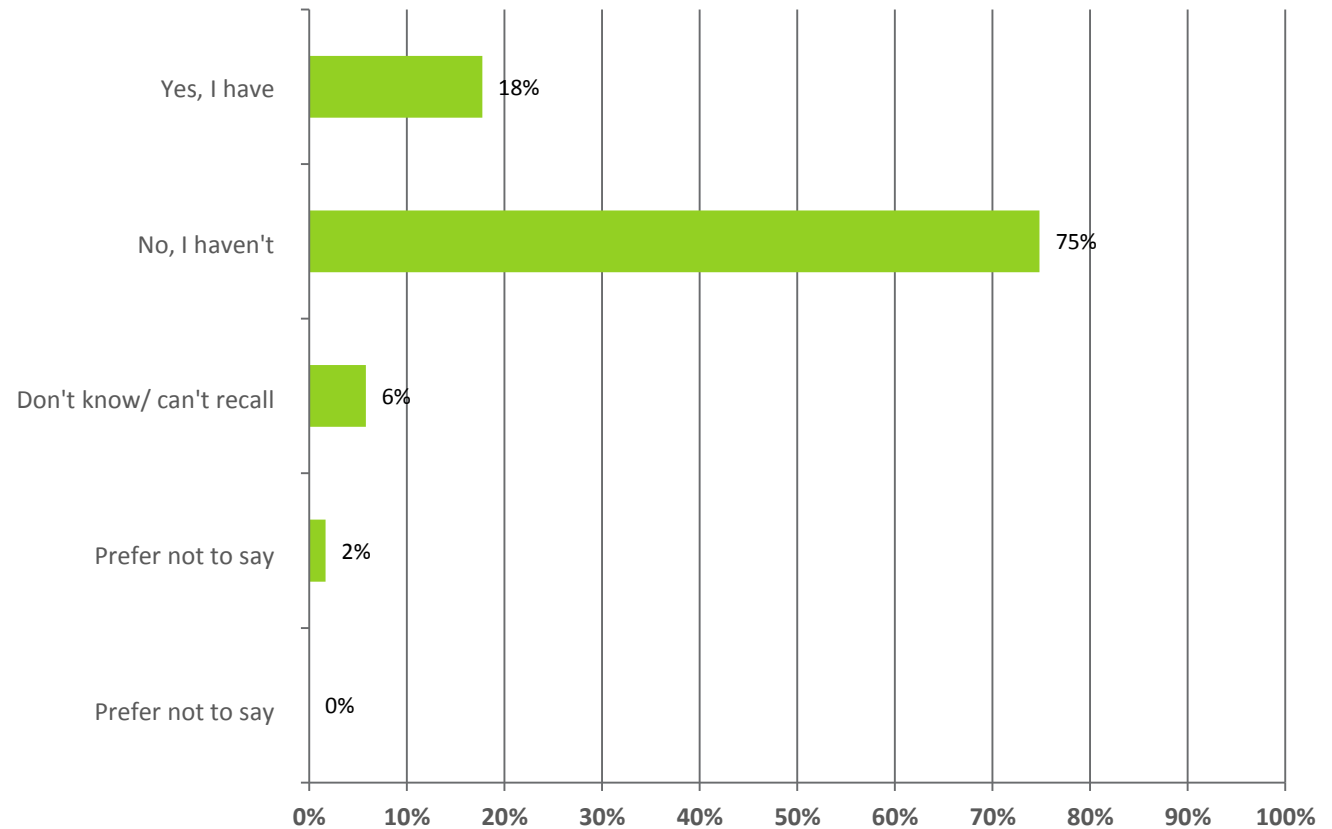

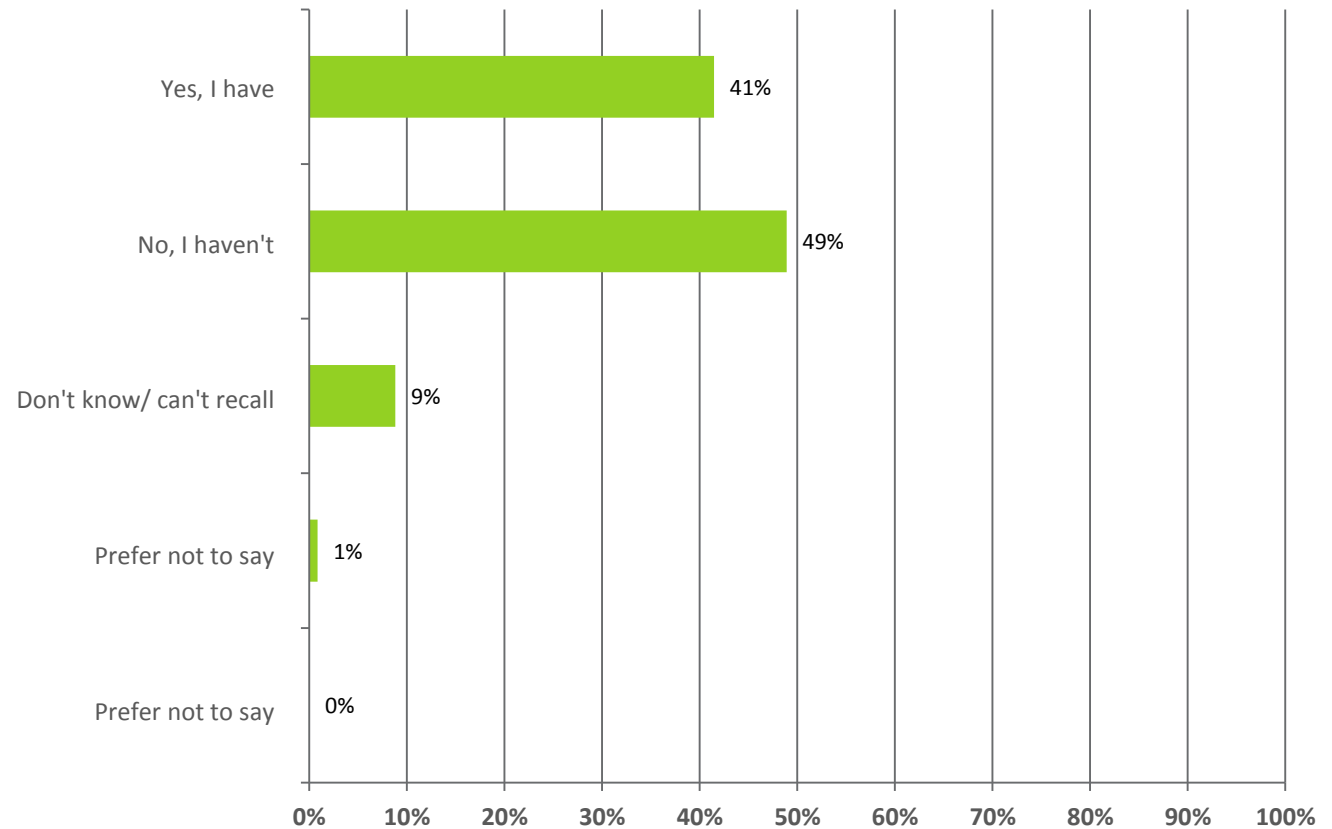

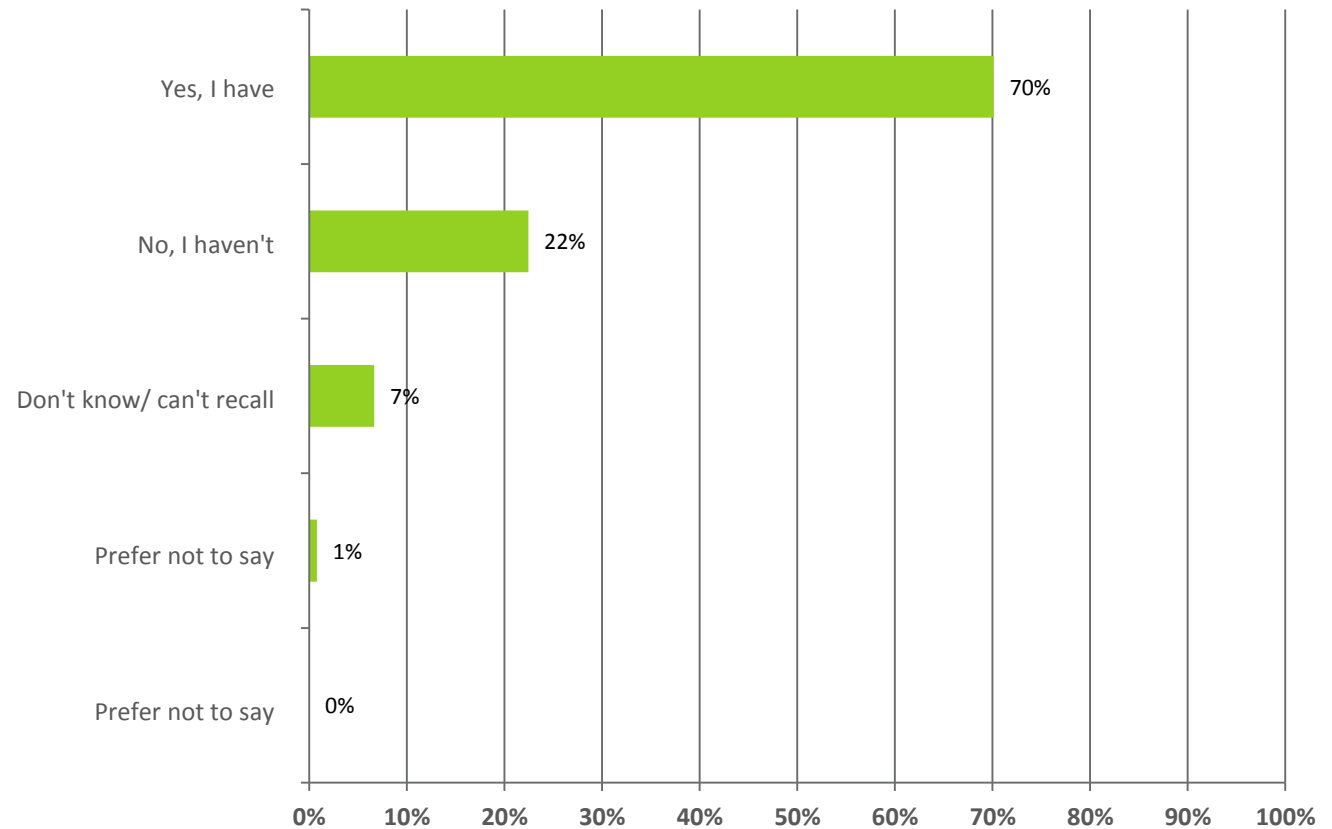

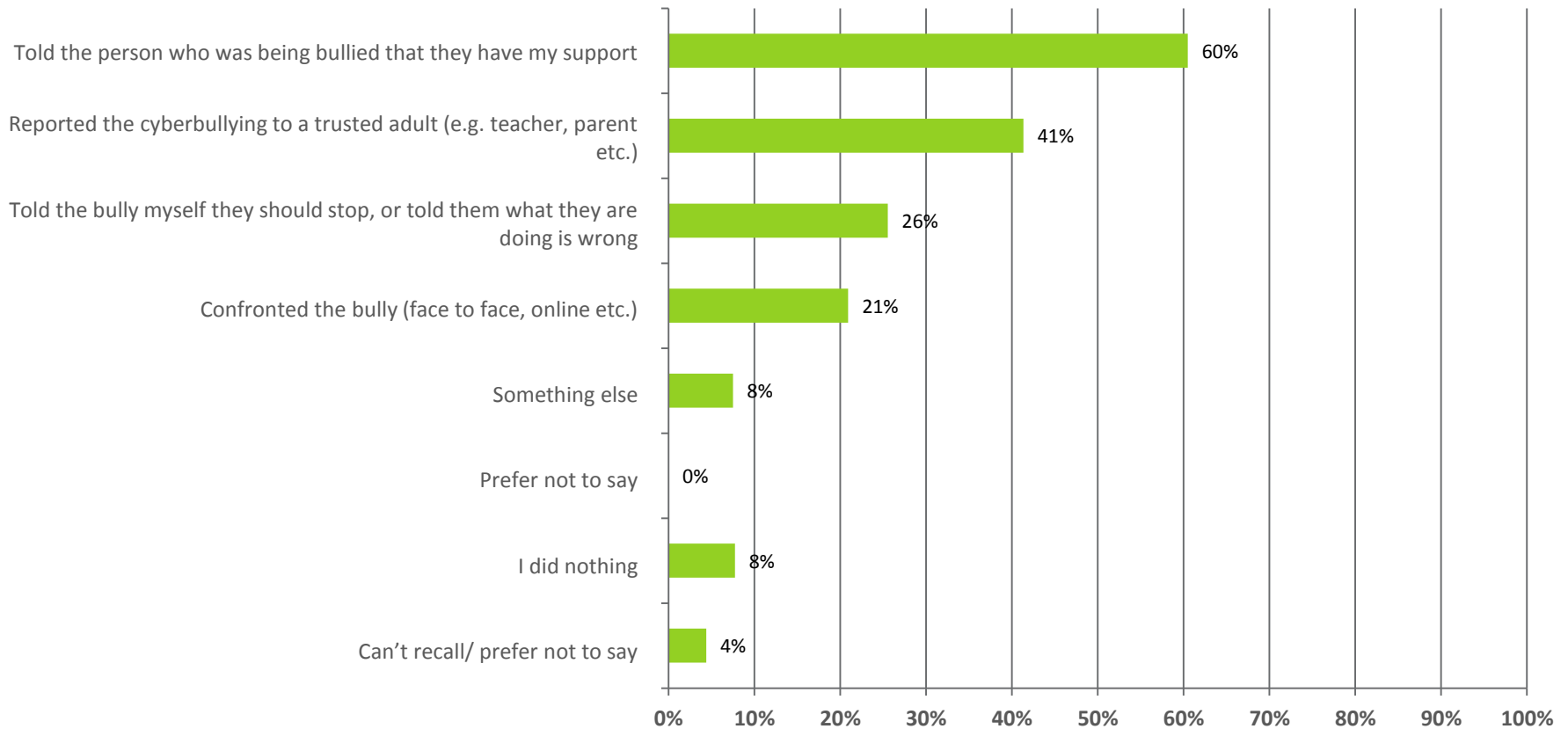

Actions as a Result of Cyberbullying

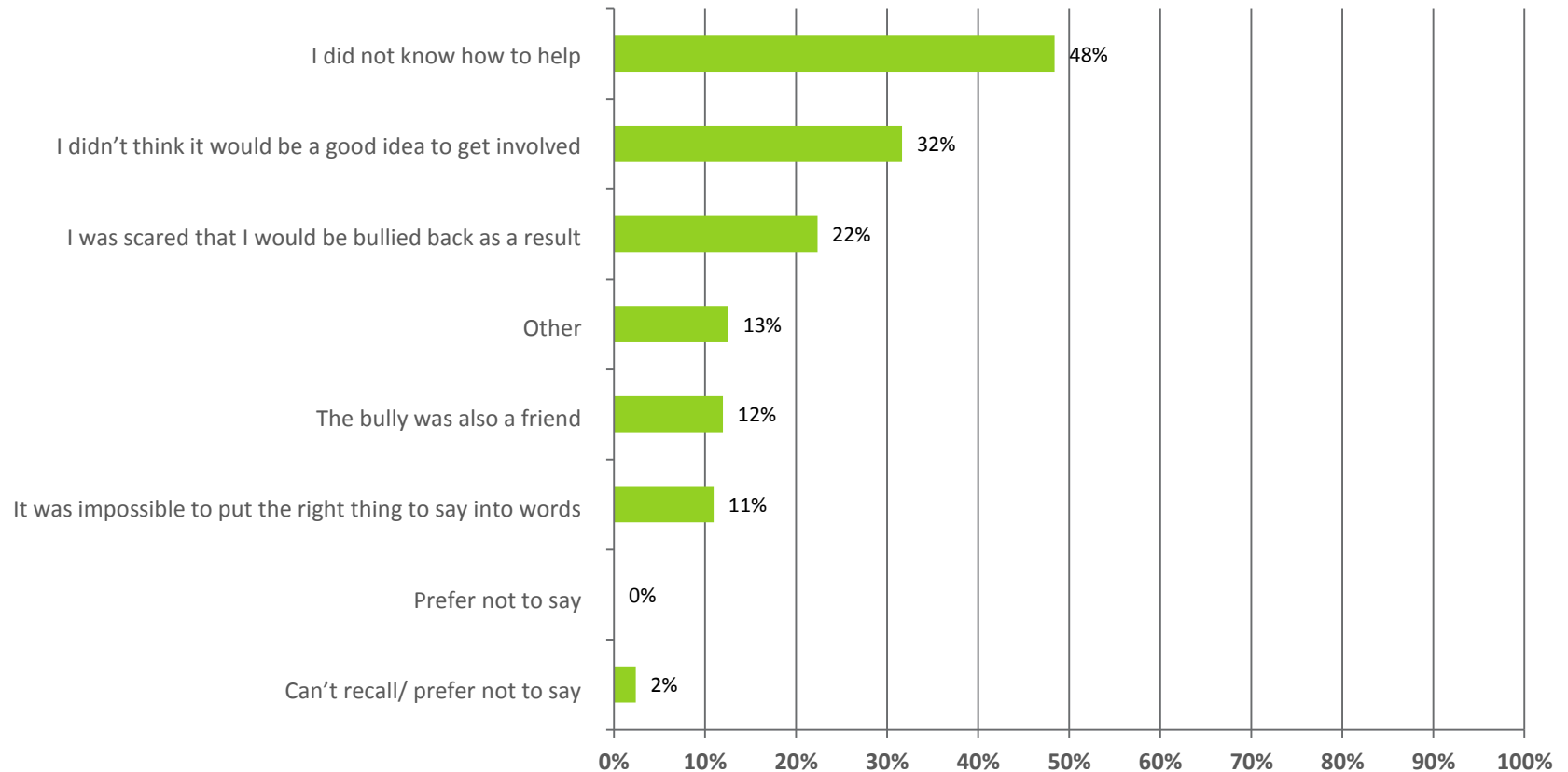

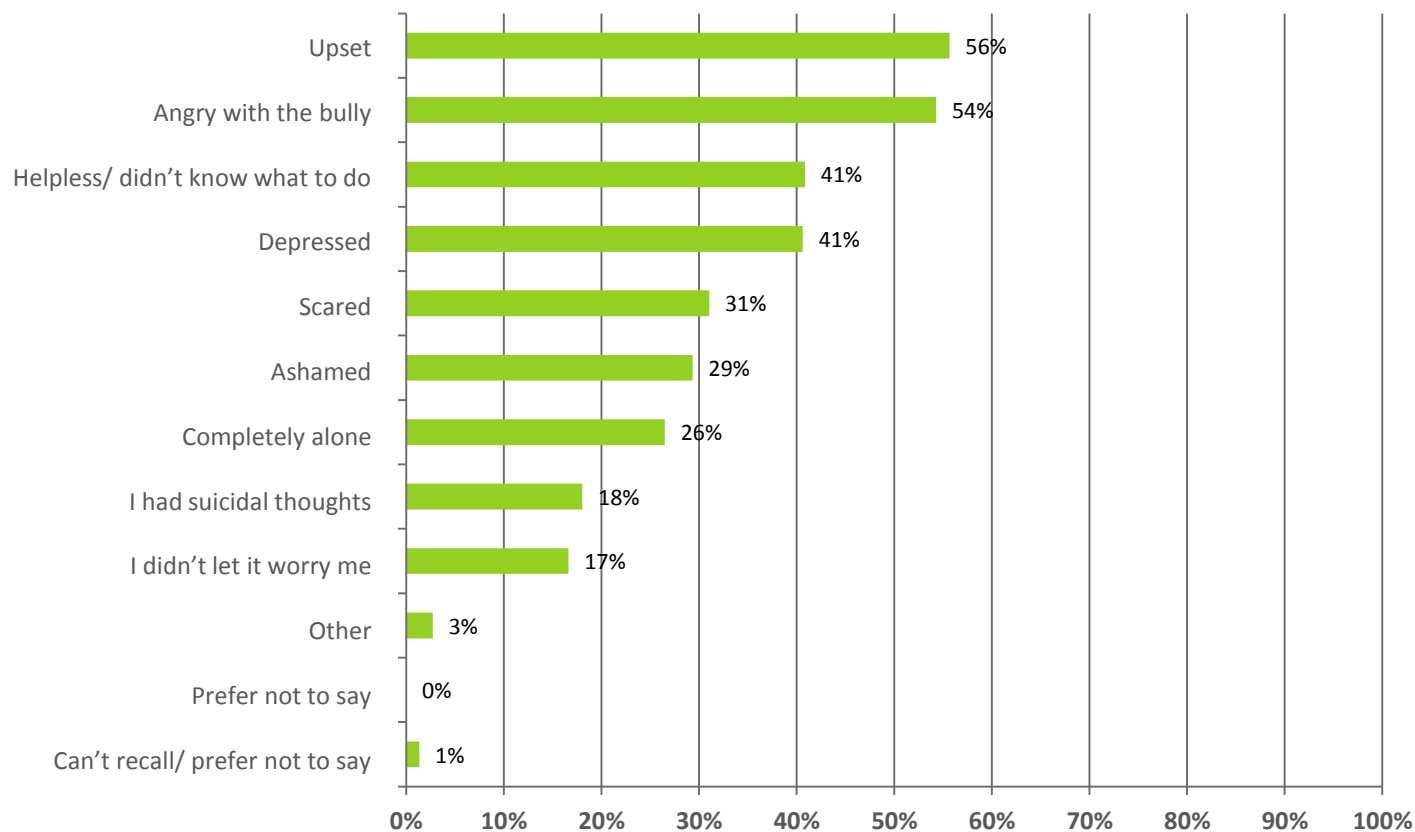

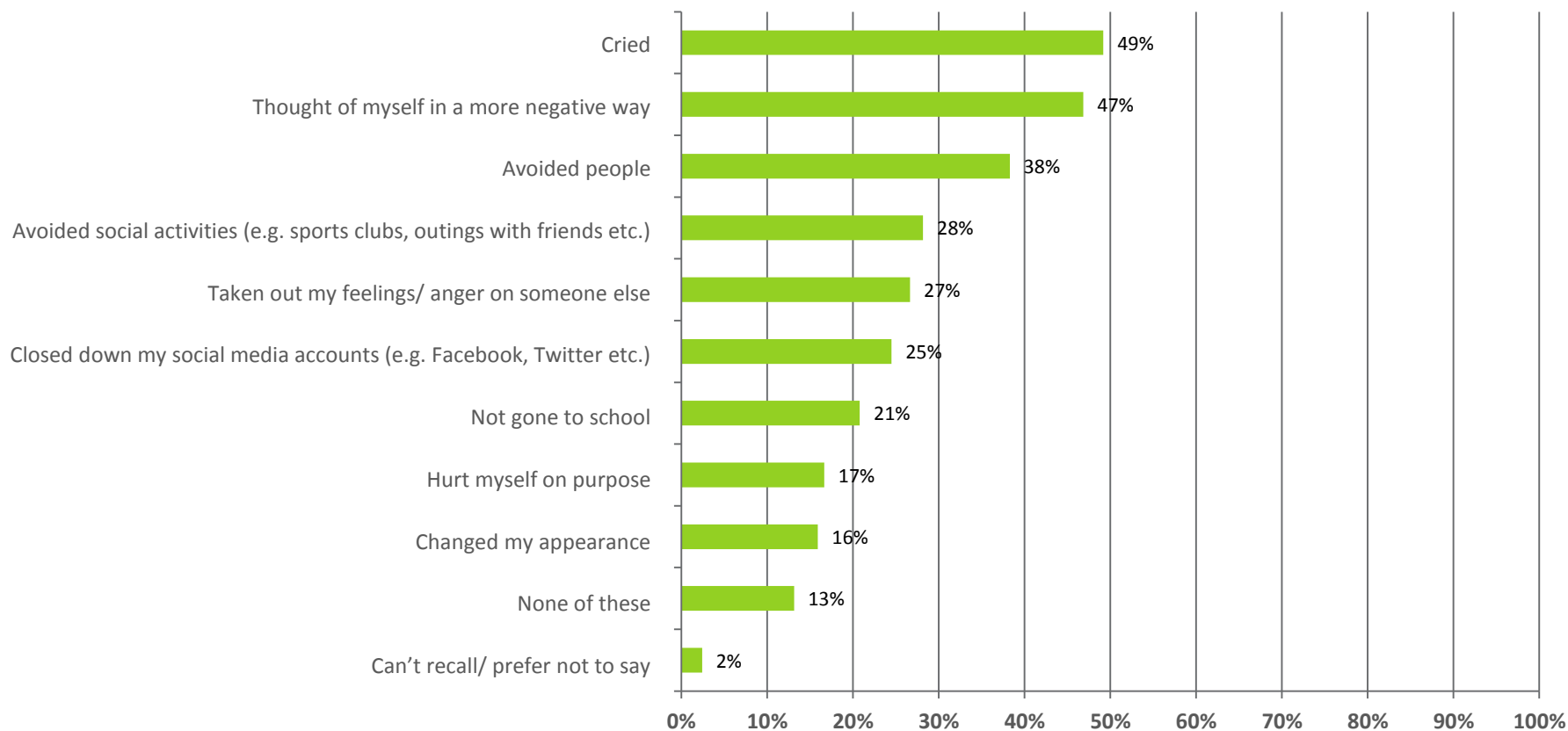

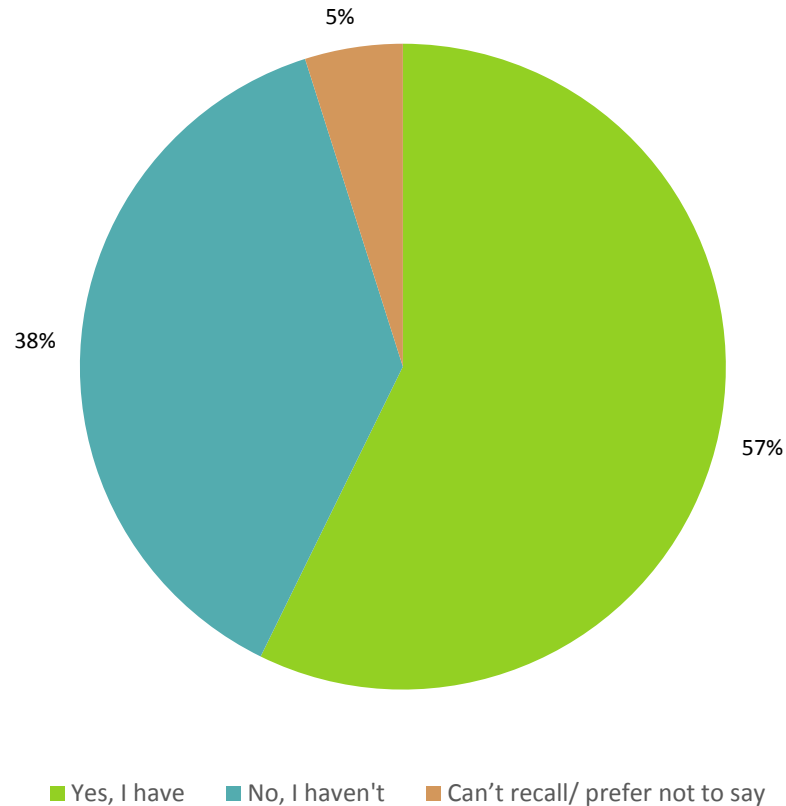

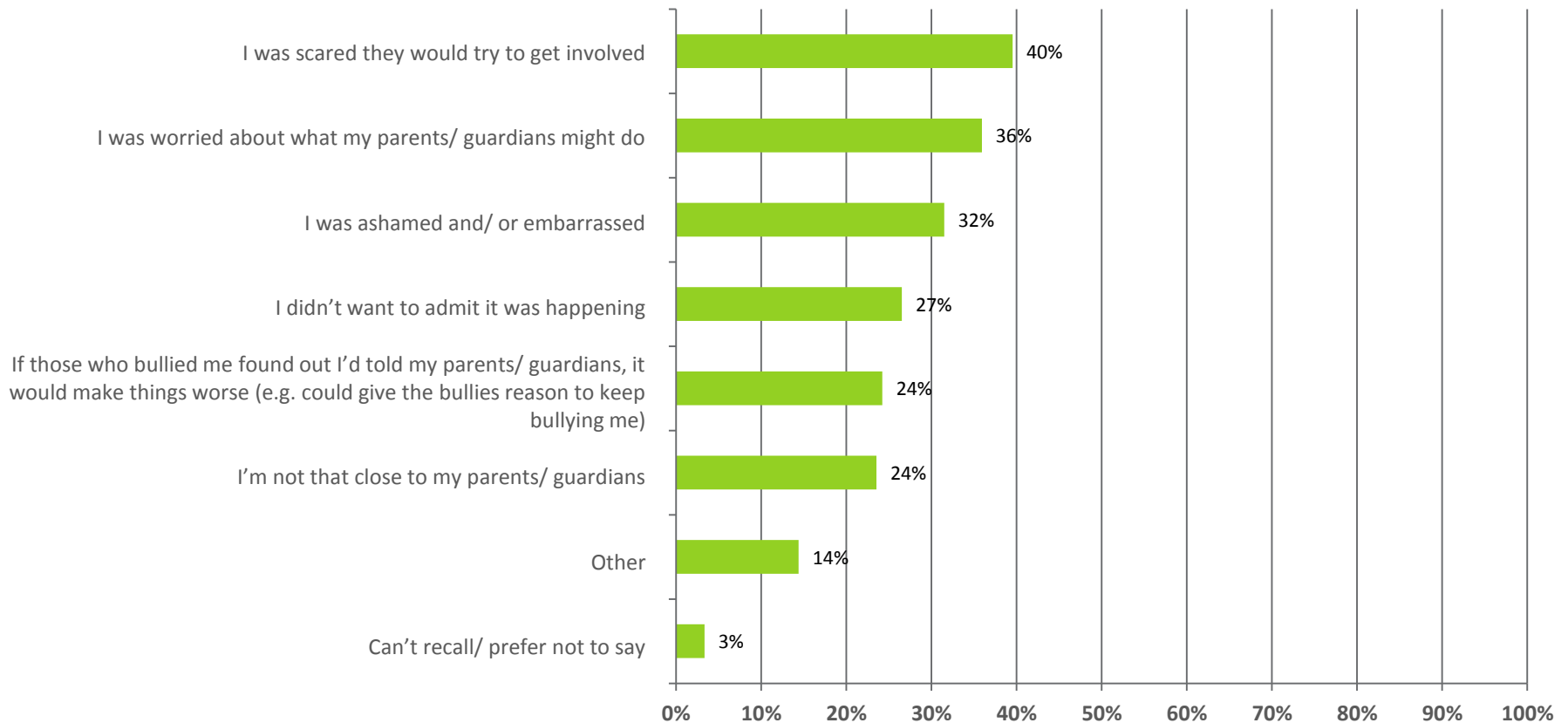

Reasons for not Informing Parents

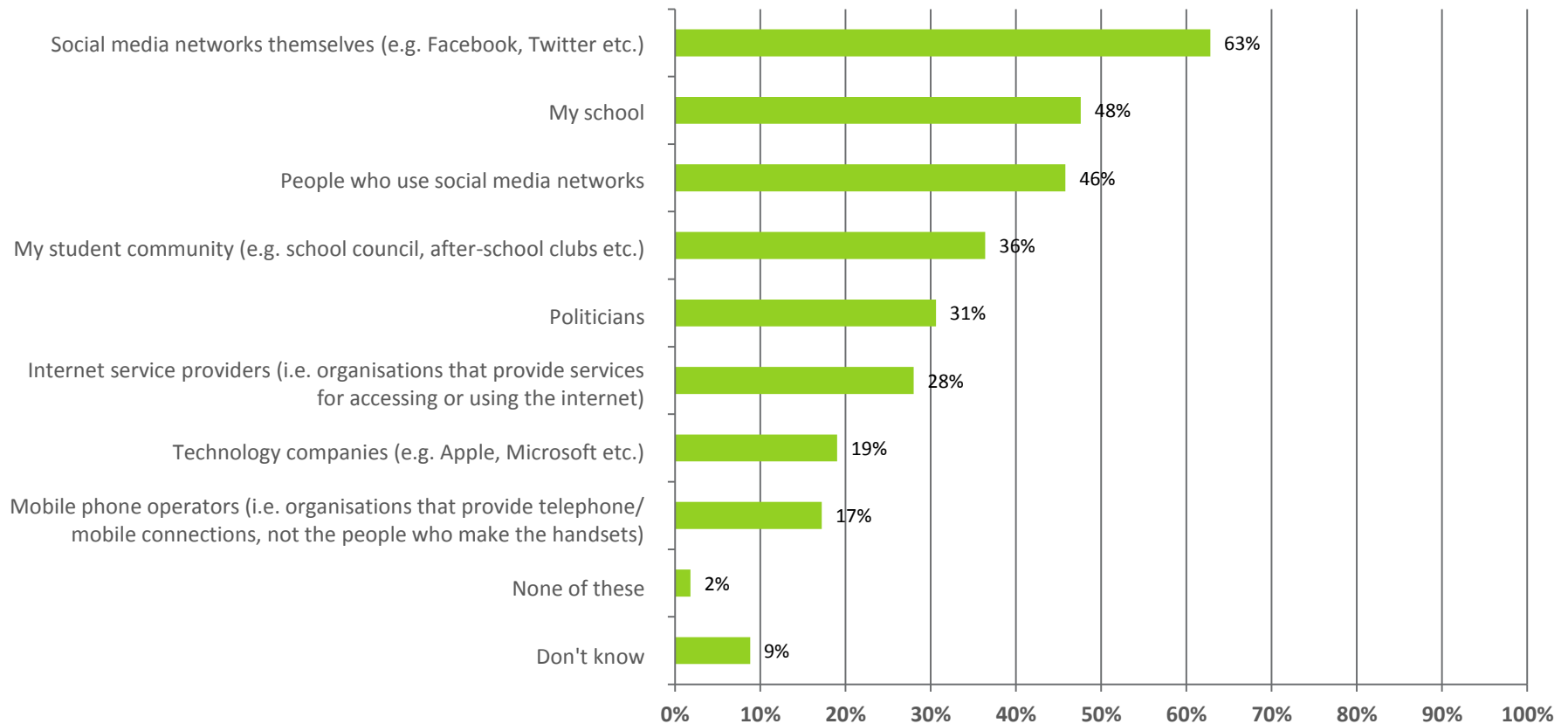
EVC_Q7. You said that you have never told your parents/ guardians you have been cyberbullied...Which of the following are reasons why? (Please select all that apply)

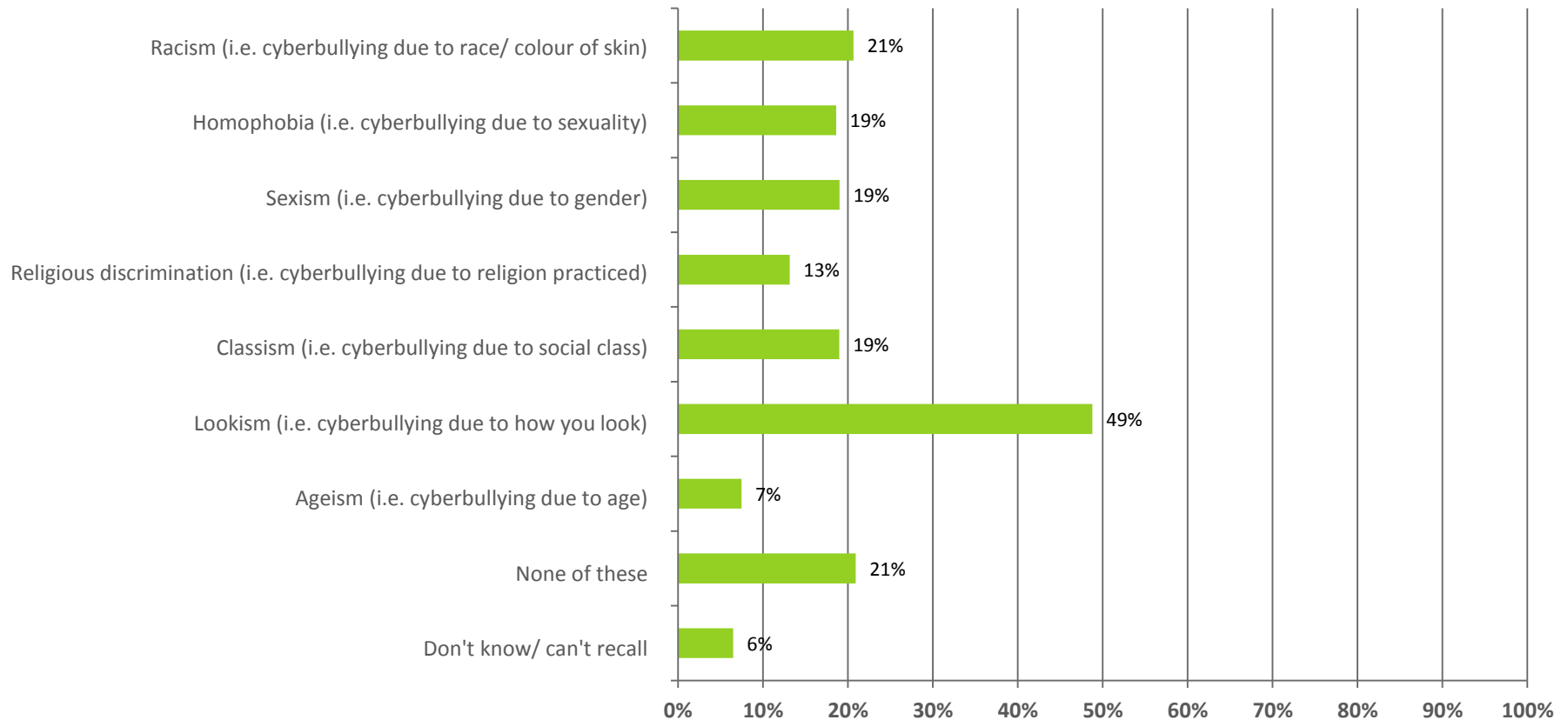
EVC_NETHERLANDSb. Which, if any, of the following people/ organisations would you like to see do more to help prevent cyberbullying? (Please select all that apply)

Types of Cyberbullying Experienced

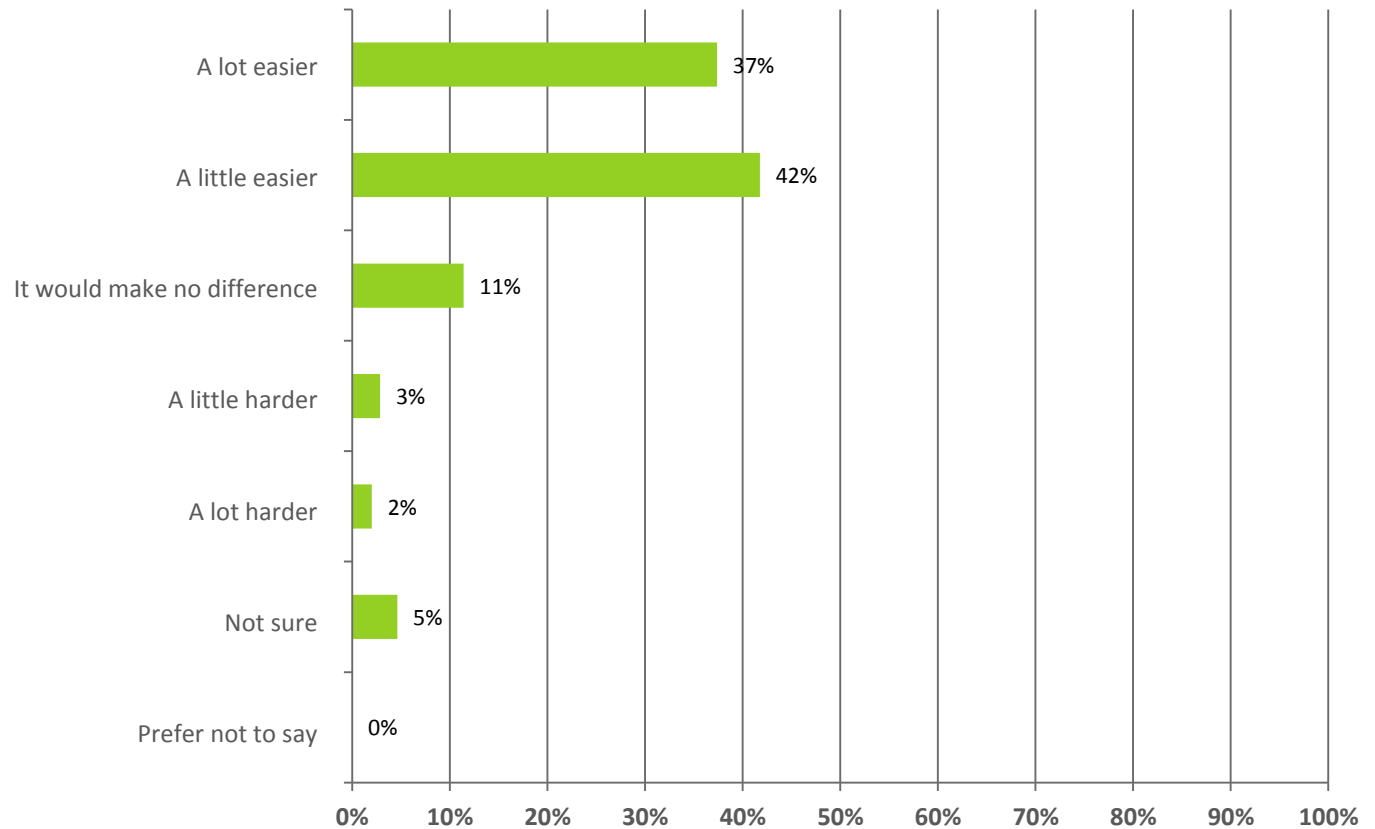
EVC_RC. Which of the following types of cyberbullying have you personally experienced/ or seen somebody else be a victim of? (Please select all that apply)

Friends/ Followers Support Social Media

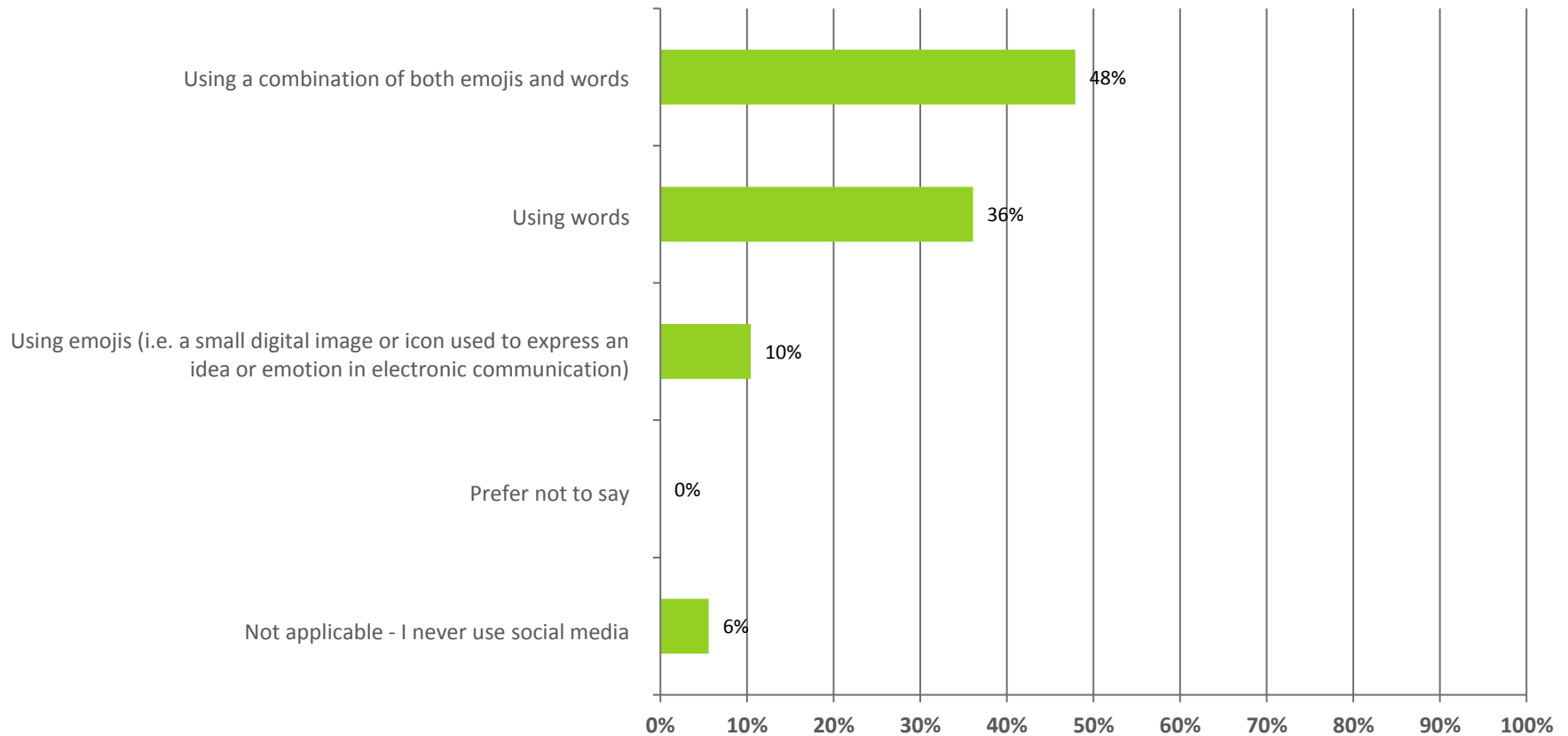

Expressing Views/ Feelings

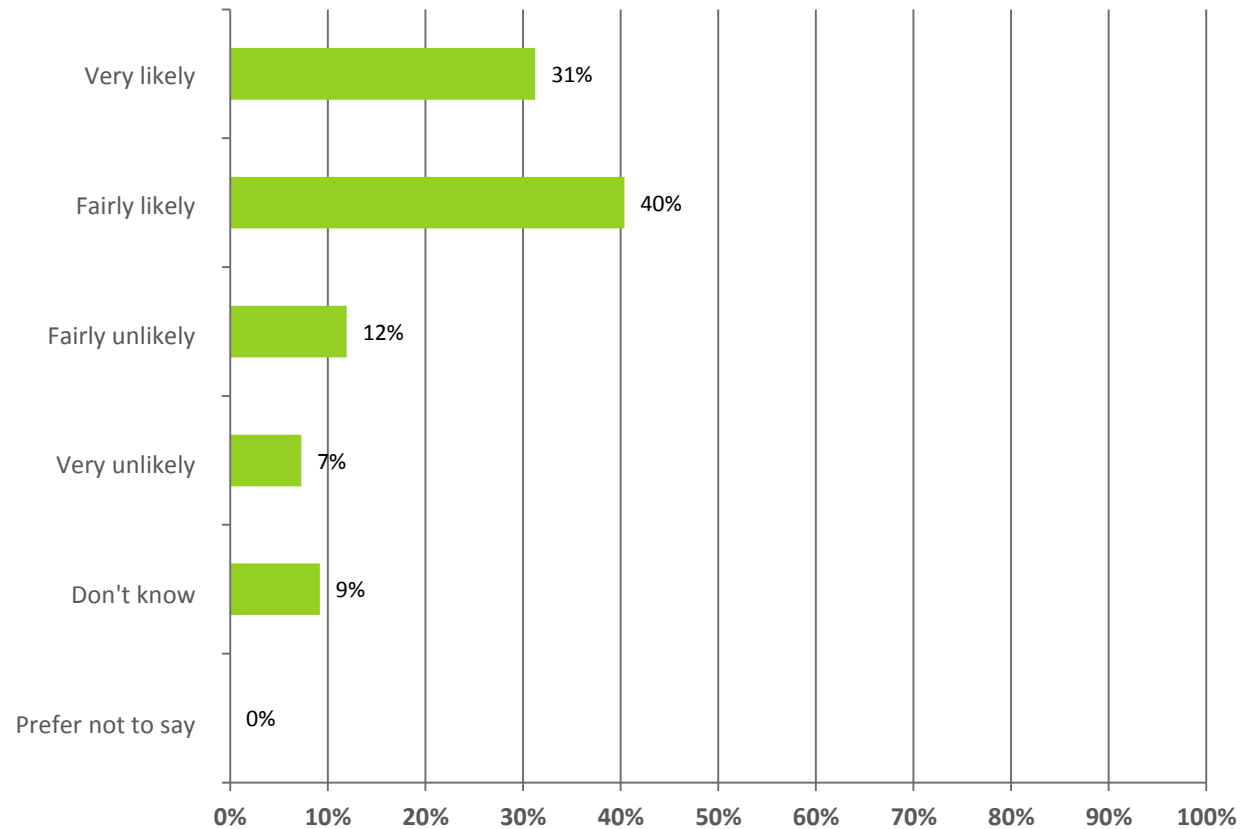

Likelihood to Share an Emoji

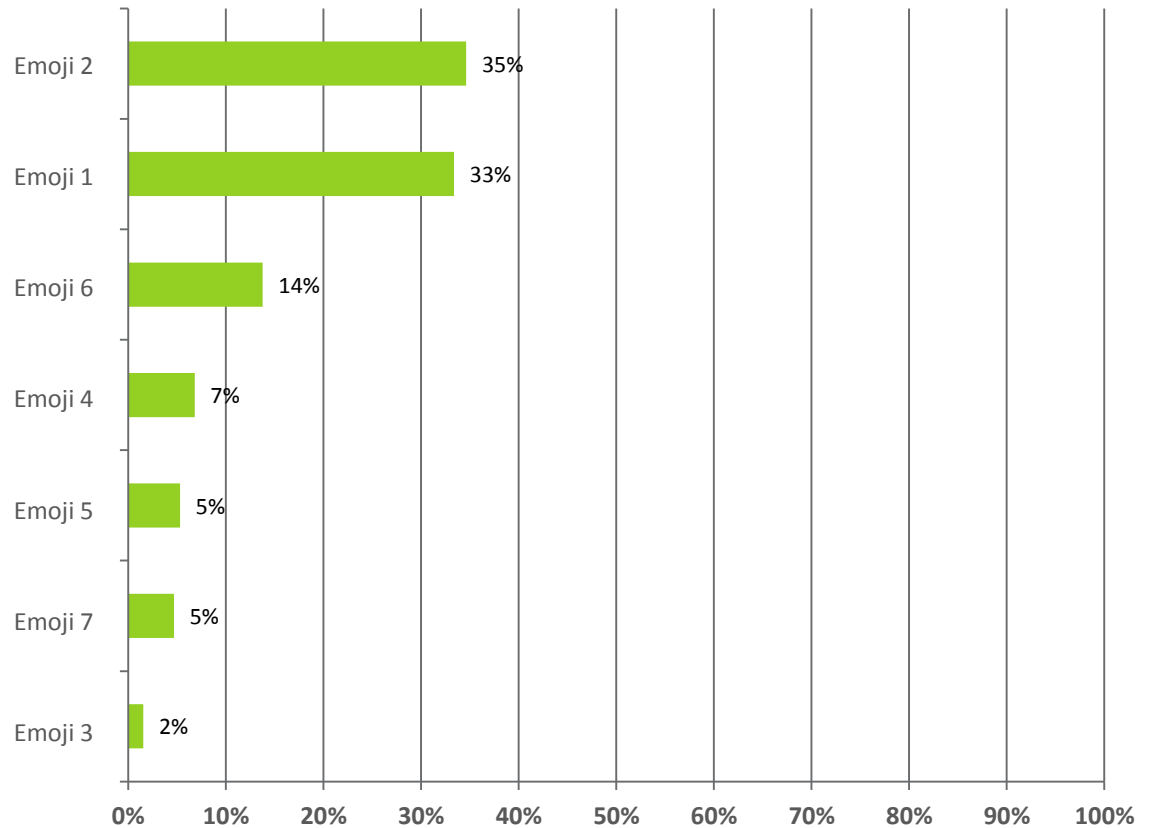
