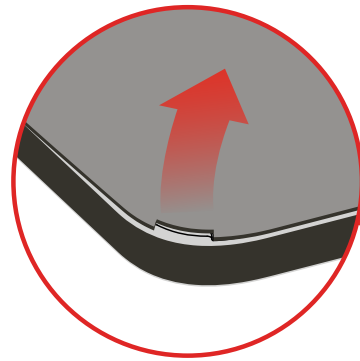

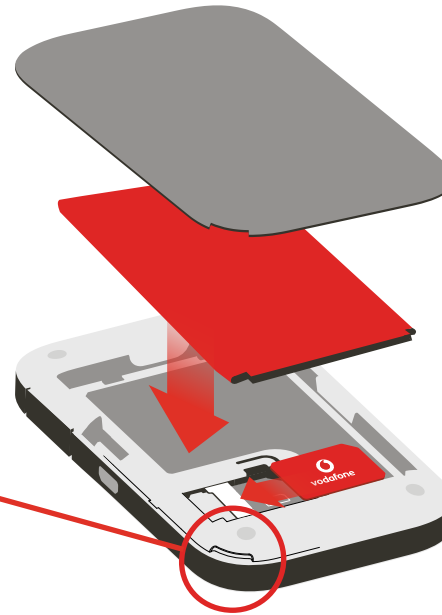

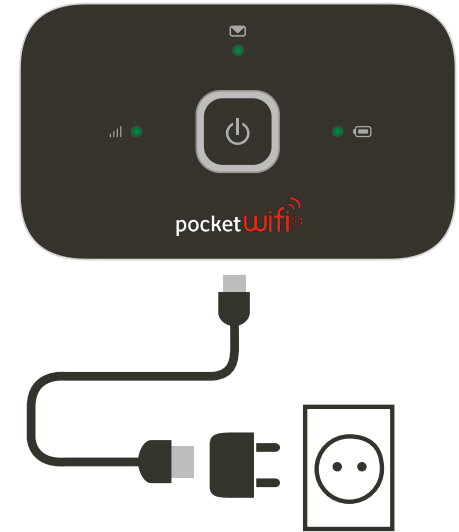
## 1 Open



## 2 Insert SIM & battery

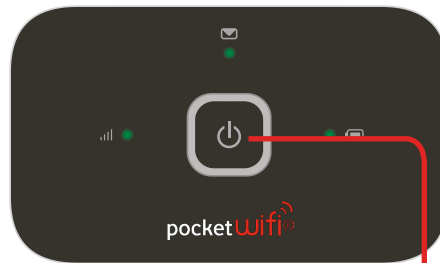


## 3 Charge

Choose WiFi on your computer, smartphone or tablet settings, then select your Pocket WiFi® network name (SSID).

Enter the password to connect and open the online dashboard.

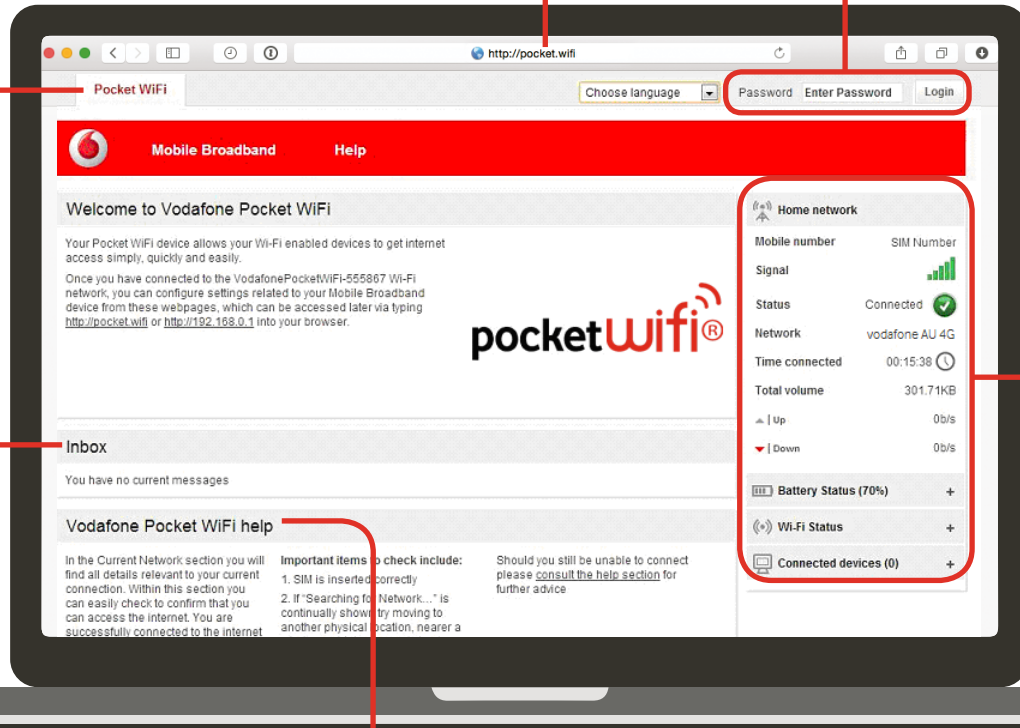

**Login**  
This lets you see additional information and make changes.  
Use the password 'admin' to log in.

Please note: you can change the default password if required. Go to 'Help' to find out how.

**Inbox**  
This lets you see SMS messages from your contacts or from Vodafone

**Help**  
This section gives you full details of how to resolve any issues.

**Status panel**  
This lets you see the status and other details about your Vodafone Pocket WiFi® and its network.  
(Note: = limited network service.)
